ESMO played a pioneer role in initiating discussion on value and costs in oncology. This dialogue should be pursued and intensified.

Inequalities in access to cancer between and even worse within countries should be overcome.

Clinical research is becoming more and more complicated to perform and huge barriers exist for patients and clinicians with regards to the participation to clinical trials. Identifying the specific barriers in different areas and tackling them is another priority.

At the same time it is extremely important to advance innovative ways to generate evidence, which will support drug development, eg capturing properly real word data or supporting innovative clinical trials.

Strategic collaboration with organizations such as WHO and EMA should be reinforced.

Free movement of clinicians and scientists in Europe should be supported. Exchanging programs, not necessarily limited to short visits or fellowships, need to be envisaged in order to build/reinforce collaboration between different countries.



Policies to help cancer survivors to be fully supported and re-integrated in society should be strengthened.

Tobacco, obesity and alcohol consumption should be thoroughly addressed, with a precise position of the Society and the definition of essential actions to be taken.
