

Declaration of Interests

Introduction

ESMO strives to attain the highest standards of integrity by adopting best practices to enhance our governance and ensure public confidence in our activities. One way in which we meet this objective is through an awareness of potential conflicts of interest.

ESMO has a Disclosure of Interests (DOI) policy that requires individuals acting on behalf of the Society to declare all interests. This policy is currently being revised and strengthened, which is why we are adopting an interim approach for elections held in 2019.

All prospective candidates at the level of President or Director are asked to complete this detailed Declaration of Interests Form. The results will be reviewed by ESMO's Compliance Committee. Since some interests may affect an individual's ability to take on a leadership role at ESMO, matters raised by the Compliance Committee will be taken into account before final candidate selection.

The DOI form (excluding value bands) of the two candidates for each position that are put forward for election will be made available to ESMO members at the time of the Electronic Ballot Vote.

Guidance

In each section, please specify interests that you or an immediate family member have held in the last three years with the following for-profit and non-profit organisations:

Pharmaceutical, diagnostic, biotechnology, medical technology and research companies, private healthcare providers, commercial medical education providers and medical societies.

Also include payments made to your institution on your behalf or in connection with your work, even if you do not make a personal gain. Select 'Institutional' or 'Personal' for each interest, as appropriate.

We ask for approximate financial details in order to understand the size of each interest. This information will be treated confidentially. For each interest, please choose the appropriate value band on the following basis:

- i) The total amount received over three years (for income); or
- ii) The present value of shares held (for publicly-traded companies); or
- iii) The percentage shareholding (for privately-held companies)

You should also declare non-financial interests from which you or an immediate family member have benefited (for example, which may be perceived as having enhanced your career, education or professional education) or which may have given you access to privileged information.
