



INSTRUCTIONS FOR POSTER DISPLAY

GENERAL INFORMATION

The MAP Congress secretariat look forward to seeing your poster on display during the meeting and thank you in advance for your co-operation in following these guidelines:

- The size of the poster must be **185 cm wide** by a maximum of **94 cm high**. Presentation format is **horizontal**.
- An optimal lay-out of your presentation will attract the attention of other Congress participants. Text should be easy to read at a distance of 1 meter.
- You must include all material to support your presentation, such as tables, drawings, charts and pictures.
- Due to current scrutiny regarding financial transparency, IT IS STRICTLY MANDATORY that you dedicate a
 section of your poster to any conflict of interests you need disclose, even if to confirm that you have nothing
 to declare.
- QR (Quick Response) and/or AR (Augmented Reality) codes are allowed in the poster, However, although
 MAP Congress Secretariat accepts that these may go to a commercial/branded website, we suggest avoiding
 links to websites containing blatant product advertising. If you intend adding a QR to your poster, please add
 the following disclaimer notice: "Copies of this poster obtained through QR (Quick Response) code are for
 personal use only and may not be reproduced without written permission of the authors." Please also refer
 to the IMPORTANT NOTICE further down.
- If the study has received funding, this must also be acknowledged on your poster: "Study sponsored by..."
- At the bottom of the poster, please include your and/or the corresponding author **email address**. This will prove especially useful if another MAP 2019 delegate wishes to contact you about your work. Having copies of your material for onsite distribution is also a good means of communication.

- Please hang your poster bearing the final publication number in the exhibition between the hours of 07:30 and 12:30 on **Friday, 8 November 2019.**
- You may remove your poster between 16:00 (after the coffee break) and 17:30 on Saturday, 9 November 2019. After 17:30 on Saturday MAP team will remove all posters left on the boards.
 Please note that the MAP congress Secretariat do not take any responsibility for returning uncollected material to the authors.
- You must be in front of your poster during the Poster display sessions scheduled on **Friday, 8 November 2019 from 13:05 to 13:50** in the Poster area located in Whittle room next to the main auditorium.
