ESMO SPEAKER CENTRE INFORMATION & PRESENTATION UPLOAD INSTRUCTIONS FOR INDUSTRY SATELLITES

ESMO thanks the Industry satellite companies and the designated representatives for their cooperation in following the guidelines below.

IMPORTANT NOTE:

For logistical reasons and to grant a smooth process, companies organising an on-site satellite symposium must upload the presentations via the **Congress backend** (link received on 26 July) or on-site at the **Speaker Centre** and need to follow the below instructions.

If you have an on-site technical rehearsal please kindly be reminded that you will have to upload your presentations via the **Congress backend** before the rehearsal.

1. CONGRESS BACKEND & SPEAKER CENTRE

1.1 Presentation upload instructions via Congress backend

Companies will be able to upload the presentations of their speakers via the Congress backend (link sent to the main administrative person on 26 July):

- from 26 July till 24 August
- from 27 August till 12 September

Benefits

- **Flexibility** of uploading the presentations from any place and at any time via the Congress backend
- Possibility to re-upload **new updated versions** of your presentation

Presentations must be uploaded **no later than 3 hours before** the start of the satellite symposium.

- Slots on **Friday, 9 September from 10:15-11:45**: presentations should be uploaded by 20:00 on Thursday, 8 September

For the other slots, the following timeline applies:

- **Lunch time satellites slots**: presentations should be uploaded by 10:00 of the same day or the preceding day
- **Evening time satellites slots**: presentations should be uploaded by 15:00 of the same day

1.2 Presentation upload instructions at the Speaker Centre

Only the company/agency designated representative (communicated to ESMO by 13 July 2022 via the online form) will be granted access to the speaker centre for upload of all satellite's presentations.

This person must be duly registered on the list and will need to identify with first name and last name upon arrival at the speaker centre.

The designated representative is requested to collect and check-in all satellite's final presentations on a USB-removable drive at the **Speaker Centre**, located in **Hall 7, Level 7.1, no later than 3 hours before** the start of the satellite symposium.

- Slots on **Friday, 9 September from 10:15-11:45**: presentations should be uploaded by 20:00 on Thursday, 8 September

For the other slots, the following timeline applies:

- **Lunch time satellites slots**: presentations should be uploaded by 10:00 of the same day or the preceding day
- **Evening time satellites slots**: presentations should be uploaded by 15:00 of the same day

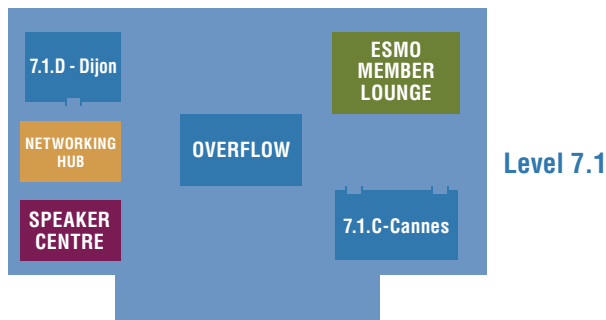
M Events staff will always be available to offer support and technical assistance during the upload of the presentations. Once the presentations have been checked, the congress technical staff will be responsible for delivering it to the auditorium in time for your satellite session.

IMPORTANT NOTE:

- Personal laptops cannot be used nor connected to the projectors in auditoria and presentations cannot be loaded directly onto the lectern laptop. Presentations must be uploaded at the speaker centre
- Technicians in the auditoria will NOT be able to receive presentations for upload directly from you
- If you have selected the option to run the ppt of your session from the back of the auditorium, please be informed of the following:
 - there will be an extra laptop located in the related auditorium from which only one person from your company, assisted from a technician, will be able to control the slides of your presentations. Kindly be reminded that it is mandatory to upload your presentations via backend or through the Speaker Centre in advance. From such extra laptop it is not allowed to process any changes on the ppt.
 - if you're having an interactive presentation, that includes a voting, it is not allowed to jump back and forth in your slides. The voting service is connected to the dedicated voting-slide within your presentation and would be restarted if you reenter the voting-slide.

2. PRESENTATION FORMATS & CATEGORIES

2.1 Presentation (PPT) format

- Please note that only Microsoft PowerPoint presentations in 16:9 format and landscape orientation (.pptx extension only) can be submitted
- If your presentation contains videos, you can either embed them into the PowerPoint presentation or link them; if you are using PowerPoint 2007 or an older version, please upload your videos separately, as they cannot be embedded into the presentation
- PowerPoint animations and transitions are only possible with the “Fade” function
- The usage of photos, gifs, animations and slide-show is supported by the system. If your presentation consists of such, it is highly recommended that the person assigned to upload the presentations in the speaker centre asks the staff for assistance to make sure all gifs, animations etc. show up properly
- Please be aware that you cannot add any links to the slides

2.2 Presentation Pre-Recording (MP4)

IMPORTANT NOTE:

If part of the faculty or any of the chair(s) are not on-site for the related satellite symposium, companies must inform immediately the ESMO Congress 2022 Secretariat (satellites@esmo.org) latest by **24 August 2022**.

For speakers not on-site, the pre-recording (video) of their lecture must be uploaded by the company administrator on the platform by **24 August 2022**. The video file must be a full HD MP4 (h.264 MPEG-4 AVC); the background layout and presentation view are entirely up to the company.

2.3 Selection of the Presentation category

At the time of the presentation upload, the designated representative is requested to select at list one topic category for each presentation. You will find the list at the bottom of the instructions. This is a mandatory field. We, therefore, advise the designated representative to approach his/her speakers in advance in case of doubts.
