



# INFORMATION FOR PRESENTERS POSTER DISPLAY

### **ON-SITE ATTENDANCE**

As presenting author, your presence is requested onsite in Madrid and you must register for the Congress. The early registration fee will be applied automatically if you register by the late registration deadline (13 September 2023).

## PREPARATION OF YOUR PRESENTATION

- Format of the poster is horizontal (landscape). The maximum poster size is 2000mm width x 1200mm height.
- You must clearly show the Final Publication Number (FPN) on your paper poster. All presenters will shortly receive an
  email with the relevant FPN, which will also be available in the online programme. Please note that the initial abstract
  submission ID is no longer valid and may restrict your poster visibility to other delegates.
- An optimal lay-out of your poster will attract the attention of other Congress participants. Text should be easy to read
  at a 1-meter distance. Use colour wherever possible. You must include all material to support your presentation, such
  as tables, drawings, charts and pictures.
- Due to current scrutiny regarding financial transparency, please include the DOI of the presenting author, even if only to confirm that he/she does not have conflicts of interest to declare, on your Poster.
- If the study has received funding, this must also be acknowledged on your poster, "Study sponsored by..."
- QR (Quick Response) and/or AR (Augmented Reality) and text key codes are allowed in the poster, however, although
  ESMO accepts that these may go to a commercial/branded website, we suggest avoiding links to websites containing
  blatant product advertising. If you intend adding a QR or a text key code to your poster, please add the following
  disclaimer notice: "Copies of this poster obtained through QR (Quick Response) and/or text key codes are for personal
  use only and may not be reproduced without written permission of the authors."
- At the bottom of the poster, please include your and/or the corresponding author email address. This will prove
  especially useful if another Congress participant wishes to contact you about your work. Having copies of your material
  for onsite distribution is allowed.
- Posters may not present a commercial bias or use clearly identifiable commercial templates, colours or branding.

#### E-POSTER UPLOAD (ESMO and EONS POSTERS)

It is mandatory to prepare an e-Poster, which will be available via searchable screens located onsite in **Hall 5**. E-Posters can be uploaded in **pptx** or **PDF format (one [1] slide/page)** – maximum file size **500 MB**.

The deadline to upload the e-Poster to the ESMO Congress portal is Thursday, 12 October 2023, 21:00 CEST.

Changes to the uploaded e-Poster may be possible; however, please note that any version uploaded after the above mentioned deadline cannot be guaranteed of publication on the Congress virtual platform, on searchable screens onsite and on OncologyPRo post Congress.

Instructions for the upload to the ESMO Congress portal will be sent to the first authors by our technical supplier on 7 August 2023.

Please note that only the first author will have access to the Presentation Management portal.





### PAPER POSTER DISPLAY

It is also mandatory to hang your **paper poster** bearing the **final publication number (FPN)** in the dedicated Poster area of **Hall 8**. Posters will be displayed for viewing for one full day according to the <u>final category</u>.

Your presence is required in front of your Poster during the Poster lunch (12:00-13:00 CEST) on the day indicated in the schedule below.
